Medication Administration at North Central High School

***The nurses **<u>DO NOT</u>** have stock medication to give to students. Medication **<u>MUST</u>** be provided by a parent/guardian along with a signed form in order for a student to receive medication while at school. ***

Form explanation can be found below:

Yellow Medication Form- is for <u>over the counter or store-bought medication</u> (i.e. Advil, Tylenol, Benadryl, Midol, etc). Parent/Guardian must fill out and sign the yellow medication form **AND** provide the medication. Medication needs to be in the original bottle or box. **NO** medication loose in baggies or envelopes will be accepted. Medication will be dispensed per direction on the medicine container.

Blue Medication Form-is for <u>prescription medication</u> as ordered by a physician. Parent/Guardian must fill out and sign the blue medication form **AND** provide medication Prescription medication needs to come in a prescriptive bottle. Medication will be dispensed per direction on the medicine container.

Green Medication Form- is for any medication that a <u>physician agrees</u> that a student may carry on their person while attending school. A physician and the parent/guardian **MUST** sign and return the green medication form. Once the signed form is received by the health center teachers and staff will be informed that the student is allowed to carry medication.

Completed forms AND medication may be dropped off at the Health Center at Panther Prep or during the school year. **NO MEDICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH OUT THE PROPER FORM.**
