

Departmental Grading Principles

Revised Grading Category Breakdown by Department

English: Mastery 65% / Practice 35%

Math: Mastery 75% / Practice: 25%

Science: Mastery 75% / Practice 25%

Social Studies: Mastery 60% / Practice 40%

PE/Health: Mastery 80% / Practice 20%

Visual Art: Mastery 70% / Practice 30%

Performing Arts: Mastery 80% / Practice 20%

ENL: Mastery 60% / Practice 40%

World Language: Mastery 70% / Practice 30%



Mastery could include tests, projects, performances, and any other assessments that teachers believe demonstrate student learning

Expectations for Retake Opportunities

Retake opportunities will be available for all summative/mastery categories following these expectations:

- All practice/formative work relating to the summative/mastery assessment must be submitted for the retake opportunity to be available.
- Students will receive credit for all practice/formative work submitted late to earn the retake but may receive up to a 10% late penalty.
- All retakes and late work must be completed within two weeks of the student having received their graded assignment, with feedback, from the teacher.
- Teachers may require a student conference to be eligible for a retake, but they must accommodate students who are not able to attend during student support hours.
- Additional remediation may be required based on a collective decision made by the teachers teaching the course.
- Students who choose not to take the initial assessment will not be eligible for retakes.
