Did you know you can have online access to your student's grades, attendance, student info, schedule, discipline, fee management, academic history, and portfolio? In addition, you are able to view and update student and family information. Your updated contact information will sync with ParentSquare, which is our school messaging service.

Skyward is accessible both online from your computer, or families are able to download an App to their phone to access their student's information.

Students have their own Skyward account, so we ask that the two accounts remain separate. Skyward allows parents/guardians to see all students in one household from the same page, so there is no need to have separate passwords to view students in different Washington Township schools.

You will be asked to change your personal password when first signing into your new account. To change your password later click on "My Account" located in the upper right-hand corner. Skyward is case-sensitive, so enter all lowercase letters.
